**What is your proposal?:** That Area 75 support a request to the General Service Conference to request a revision be made to the pamphlet "A.A. For The Woman" which was last revised in 1986 to update some of the stories to be more relevant for a woman coming to A.A. today.

**How did this proposal originate?:** Our Hartford Womens Big Book Group reviewed the pamphlet and at our July 2013 meeting voted to request a revision. We then sent a letter to our DCM in District 12 and at the October 2013 district meeting the district voted to support a revision. It was suggested that the request include some specific items that should be revised and the following items were identified:

- Inside front cover – Page numbers of stories copyrighted by A.A. Grapevine, Inc. do not align with start of stories.
- Page 5 – some younger members wondered who Ann Landers was. The questions are still relevant so maybe mention she was an advice columnist.
- Story starting on page 10 contains material which date the story, such as reference to crashing into a stanchion and the Bowery
- Story starting on page 13 sounds dated. Today children would be in foster care and not an orphanage, mention of "Kentucky Gentleman"
- Story starting on page 18 – reference to year 1977 dates the story, nurses don't wear white uniforms and caps today
- Story starting on page 24 – reference to tranquilizers, doctor stating you can't become addicted to tranquilizers, etc.
- Story starting on page 27 is very dated. Should be replace with a story that reflects a more typical "housewife" today.
- Where to find A.A. on page 35 needs to be updated to include reference to website, availability of phone meetings, etc.
